I am the managing General Partner of a shopping center located at the intersection of Routes 35 and 36 in Eatontown, New Jersey.

On March 4, 2005 we suffered a most tragic and horrific event. While trenching to put in a new electric line on the property, the contractor hit an apparently unmarked gas line. A major explosion occurred in a 15,000-foot store causing a section of floor and roof to collapse trapping a number of people in the building.

This catastrophic event brought out fire and emergency units throughout the region. Much to my surprise and gratitude Fort Monmouth answered this situation with several large aerial trucks which played a major role in the locating and rescuing trapped people. These professionals also helped in the stabilization of the structure that most fortunately and miraculously resulted in the rescue of all without loss of life. Photographs are enclosed.

As a result of this event, so many others and I realized just how important a role Fort Monmouth plays in the community. Consequently, without question the role of Fort Monmouth transcends strictly its' important military role and supplies an most imperative role for the community.

I would be remiss not to bring this to your attention for your consideration of the value of this installation in your difficult deliberations.

Dear BRAC Commissioners:

I am writing to you to urge you to save Fort Monmouth from closure. Fort Monmouth has provided technology that makes our soldiers safer and more effective.

With an enemy that is constantly changing tactics, our army must be more flexible, more versatile and better equipped. It is research and development that makes those things possible. I am therefore disturbed to hear that research and development were not part of the criteria used to evaluate bases when compiling the BRAC list.

It is the research and development done at Fort Monmouth that first created the walkie-talkies which allowed troops to stay in contact across the battlefield. It is research and development at Fort Monmouth that created technology to locate the source of motor fire within seconds of launch, which allows our troops to respond quickly and accurately. It is research and development at Fort Monmouth that created technology that jams the signal to detonate roadside bombs. These are just some of the highlights of what Fort Monmouth has done and continues to do for the men and women in our armed services.

It is clear that research and development are an integral part of military value. As such, it is clearly something that must be considered when evaluating bases for closure.

These technologies were created by a dedicated group of military and civilian personnel. These personnel have not only created integral relationships within the Fort and but have also created relationships with others in the high-tech sector of New Jersey. These relationships are what make Fort Monmouth great.

With a wealth of research and development knowledge in one place, Fort Monmouth has been able to quickly and easily adapt to changing battlefields and has produced technology that keeps our soldiers safe and effective. Without the intellectual capital of Fort Monmouth, our military would face new challenges with the same old equipment. It is unthinkable that we would jeopardize our troops' safety or effectiveness while we are engaged in a war.

I urge you to keep Fort Monmouth off the closure list.

I am sending this letter to request that the BRAC Commission remove Fort Monmouth from the list of base closings.

I am a resident of Middletown, New Jersey and I am the Chair of Monmouth University's Software Engineering Department in West Long Branch, New Jersey. I am writing this letter, not in my official employment capacity, but as a private citizen. I have reviewed the testimony that was presented by New Jersey's delegation to the commission a few weeks ago and I would like to take this opportunity to provide some additional data, opinions and feedback to the Commission.

First, I would like to address the negative economic impact that a closure of Fort Monmouth would have on the central New Jersey area. During the past five years this area of New Jersey has suffered from the loss of nearly 15,000 jobs caused by the extremely serious financial condition of the telecommunications industry. Many of my friends who were employed by AT&T, Agere, Avaya, Lucent Technologies and Telcordia have been forced to retire early or were laid-off. A few of those who were the technically most competent were fortunate to find jobs at Fort Monmouth or with one of the contract companies that support the Army's Communications Electronics Research and Development Command at Fort Monmouth. Most of the others are still unemployed because they have been unable to find employment in the local area. Where there were 15,000 jobs there are now only about 2,000 telecommunications industry jobs. Elimination of Fort Monmouth from the local area would eliminate approximately an additional 5,000 jobs at the Fort and numerous additional local jobs at companies like Lockheed-Martin, MITRE, Grumman, Ilex, etc. that currently provide support for the Army's work at Fort Monmouth. In my opinion, closure of the Fort would make employment conditions in the local area unbearable.

Second, I would like to address the impact on our nation's ability to defend itself during a time of war. As I am sure you are well aware, an Army Software Engineering Center is located at Fort Monmouth. During the past several years, in my capacity as Chair of the Software Engineering Department at Monmouth University, I have worked closely with the management of the Army's Software Engineering Center (SEC) to both attract excellent new computer science and engineering employees to employment with the Army and to improve their ability to acquire, develop and maintain software systems and

applications for the US Army. We have done this via an internship program for new SEC employees who qualify for both employment and graduate work. The Army pays their tuition and allows them to take time off during their first 2-3 years of employment to attend classes and study. The results for the Army are strong, well trained software engineering employees who stay employed with the Army. During the past 19 years that this program has been in place almost 300 Army civilian employees have participated in the program and approximately 75% of them are still working with the Army – an amazingly high retention rate!


This fall we expect that there will be a total of 58 interns participating in the program. During informal conversations that I have had with many of them they have indicated their concern with the potential closure and relocation of the base. All that I have talked with want to finish their education and their continuing employment commitment to the Army as soon as possible because they say that they will not relocate, particularly if the base operations move to Aberdeen, Maryland. At Aberdeen there are no universities within commuting distance at which employees could participate in a graduate software engineering program like the one that we have developed in Monmouth County, NJ.

I cannot imagine that the Commission would make a decision to close Fort Monmouth now, during a time when its civilian employees and the employees of surrounding contracting companies are supporting the war in Iraq and when they are becoming increasingly involved in homeland security. The increasing importance of software systems in both of these missions and the results of our joint work in building the Army's ability to develop and acquire software with the local civilian employee base would be lost if operations are moved out of the area.

I hope that as the Commission begins its final deliberations you will consider these additional factors, which, although they may be a small part of the total set of factors that need to be considered, they are very important.



Dear Mr. Coyle:

Earlier today I wrote and sent the attached letter to Chairman Principi. I am forwarding this copy to you to call your attention to the letter and to add one additional point that may be of interest to you because of your professional background.

As a part of the Masters Degree Program in Software Engineering at Monmouth University in which the Army Software Engineering Center interns participate I have the privilege of teaching two courses, Software Project Management and Software Quality and Testing. As I am sure you know, the management of software development and the provision of high quality software to our fighting forces is both very important and also very difficult.

The courses in which the Army interns participate in these areas are both very rigorous and very practical. I have been teaching these courses at Monmouth University for the past 4 years and I have had the pleasure of having approximately 40 of the Army interns in my classes on those subjects. I would venture to say, in all modesty, that those 40 Army employees have more expertise in software project management, software quality and software testing than any other set of DOD employees. The reason for this is not that I am so good at what I do or that they are such excellent students. The reason is that there very few courses like these available as part of any software engineering masters degree programs.

In the project management course we do cover most of the standard things covered in project management courses. However, we put special emphasis on the relationships between software project management and the underlying business and technical processes such as software design inspections and software testing. In the software quality and testing course we teach students how to do software design inspections as well as how to develop and implement inspection programs. In that course we also go very deeply into white box and black box test case development methods and finish the course with a segment on software comprehension and maintenance.

If Fort Monmouth is closed and the Software Engineering Center is moved to any other location their new employees will no longer have the opportunity to participate in courses like these at almost any price.

I hope that with your special knowledge and background in development and testing you will add these considerations to the others being considered by the commission.

Dear BRAC Commissioners:

I am writing to you to urge you to save Fort Monmouth from closure. Fort Monmouth has provided our armed services with technology that has protected our troops and has made them more effective on the battlefield. Fort Monmouth has been responsible for technology that has over and over again proved to be effective in protecting our troops. One important example is the technology that has jammed signals intended to detonate roadside bombs.

Fort Monmouth has been able to provide these advances because its employees, both military and civilian, provide a wealth of experience and expertise that cannot be duplicated or replaced.

The institutional knowledge at Fort Monmouth has been gathered over decades of trial and error. It is that kind of knowledge that fosters development of technology that makes our soldiers safer and more effective. It is that expertise that has allowed Fort Monmouth to earn a reputation as a leader of innovation on the battlefield.

While the employees of Fort Monmouth have worked diligently to improve the quality of life for our armed forces, they have also created a better quality of life here in Monmouth County. They have built homes, nurtured families and planted roots.

Many of these people are civilian employees who will not uproot themselves and their families if Fort Monmouth was to close. Instead, the Army would lose that valuable intellectual capital, innovation would slow and, I fear, we would no longer be able to quickly adapt to the changing needs of our Armed Services.

Fort Monmouth also benefits from strong relationships with New Jersey's universities, research labs and high-tech workforce. It is these relationships that allow Fort Monmouth to quickly and effectively develop technology that is crucial to our soldiers. If Fort Monmouth's mission was to relocate, those relationships would be lost. It would take decades before such intellectual capital could be regained.

In these quickly changing times, it is imperative to maintain the high standards Fort Monmouth has set for itself. I urge you to keep Fort Monmouth off the closure list.
