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Pete -- DON comments on 6 August ISG minutes:

1. Generally agree with suggested AF changes to minutes.
2. In particular, concur with recommendation to change 48 hours for scenario data calls from a will to may. Our recollection of that discussion was that we needed to be prepared to respond quickly, perhaps as quickly as 48 hours -- rather than a definitive decision of due dates.
3. Concur also with recommendation to characterize 15 Dec as a target date vice a due date. My recollection of the discussion was that VCNO tried to raise the issue of reasonableness of the schedule without success. I do not remember an "agreement" to change the date to 15 Dec.
4. Only additional issue is the statement on page 2 that "Scenarios will be monitored and tracked by the ISG." I'm not sure what is meant by that, nor do I remember any discussion. I am assuming that this means scenarios will be put into a tracking tool (as we discussed this past Wednesday), rather than that the ISG will positively control all scenarios (including MilDept scenarios). Perhaps it might be better to add a phrase at the end "...by means of a tracking tool to be developed by the OSD BRAC Office."
