CAFB is a valuable asset to the government, as Rep. Heather Wilson stated;


"Once you shut a base, you can never get it back".

CAFB meets & exceeds the criteria required by the Pentagon officials who developed the base closure list.

1. Expanded Air Space.
2. Expanded bombing range (Melrose Bombing Range).
3. Recently approved Supersonic Corridor (effective 10/1/05).
4. CAFB has been protected from any encroachments of the facility.
5. CAFB has the ability to expand the base in any direction.
6. CAFB is a modern 'state of the art' military facility with infinite capacity & diversification.
7. 27th Fighter Wing is known at the Pentagon as the 'Go To' mobile group in response to the new extremist (terrorist) driven 'War Theater'.
8. Cost of land and services is lower in the rural Southwest.
9. 320 days (annual average) of good flying weather.
10. Cost of flying operations is lower due to close proximity to Melrose Bombing Range, expanded Air Space and the new Supersonic Corridor.
