TITLE: S&S-0043R PRIVATIZE SUPPLY, STORAGE AND

GENERAL DESCRIPTION: Privatizes the wholesale supply, storage and distribution of tires used by DoD. Specific functions to be privatized include inventory management, requirements forecasting, acquisition, retrograde management, receiving, storing, issuing, inspecting, transporting and disposing of tires. The scenario envisions privatized activities being performed at contractor facilities which frees up government infrastructure and reduces requirements for personnel. Contractors will be expected to make direct deliveries of tires to customer organizations within the US and to strategic distribution platforms for OCONUS customers.

NOTES:

1. Anniston Army Depot expected to lose approximately 1 civilian position due to privatization in 2007.
2. Detroit/Selfridge expected to lose approximately 30 civilian positions due to privatization in 2007
3. Tobyhanna and Corpus Christi Army Depot have no personnel changes.
