Subj: **ARMY VIRTUAL ICPS**

1. This is to inform you that in deliberative session on 14 February 2005, the Principals of the Supply and Storage Joint Cross Service Group decided to consider the Army proposal to establish a virtual ICP with the TABS organization acting as a subcontractor to the S&S JCSG.

Subcontracting means that the S&S JCSG assigns a scenario number, TABS does all the scenario data call and clarifications work/collection from the Army ICPs, submits the data to the S&S JCSG in the required time frames, and the S&S Principals remain the deliberative body on the final recommendation of the scenario.

This proposed scenario realigns and consolidates outlying IMMC organizations at their respective Lead IMMC locations; it moves CSLA, Ft Huachuca to CECOM, Ft Monmouth, and moves TACOM-Natick, TACOM-Rock Island to TACOM, Warren MI. The scenario also establishes a virtual AMC ICP for secondary items with a small HQ staff at Ft Belvoir with operational cells at TACOM, CECOM, and AMCOM.
