SUBJECT: Temporary Stationing of Army Brigade Units of Action

- November 15, 2002, Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) memo, subject: Transformation Through Base Realignment and Closure, requires all realignment and closure actions not applicable under section 2687 of Title 10 to be approved on the basis of guidance by USD (AT&L).
- On January 30, 2004, OSD approved increasing Army force structure by ten modular brigades for FY 2004-2006 and deferred a decision until FY 2006 to build five more in FY 2007.
- The proposed stationing does not involve the relocation of any DoD civilian authorizations.
- In FY04, new brigade units of action will be formed and temporarily stationed at Fort Stewart, Georgia; Fort Campbell, Kentucky; and Fort Drum, New York.
- In FY05, new brigade units of action will be formed and temporarily stationed at Fort Richardson, Alaska; Fort Lewis, Washington; and Fort Carson, Colorado.
- Temporary stationing for initial modular brigade units of action is operationally imperative now; permanent stationing will be fully addressed through the BRAC 2005 analysis.
- Stationing decisions for remaining brigades are pending further analysis of stationing requirements and operational needs.
