**GENERAL DESCRIPTION:** Realign, and co-locate the following organizations at a Military Base in the National Capital Region (Bethesda, MD - Navy installation). The purpose of this scenario is to move all activity of the following organizations located at the sites indicated and co-locate them in close proximity.

Realign all ONR activity at Ballston, VA; Realign all DARPA activity at Ballston, VA; Realign all DTRA activity at Ft Belvoir; Realign all Army Research Office activity at Durham, NC; Realign all Army Research Office activity at Ft Belvoir; Realign all Army Research Lab, CIS/SLA activity at Ballston, VA; Realign all AFRL/AFOSR activity at Ballston, VA.

Scenario affects Army sites as follows:

1. Realigns approximately 300 personnel from Ft Belvoir;
2. Realigns approximately 100 personnel from Ballston Leased
3. Realigns approximately 100 personnel from ARO/Durham Leased
4. Realigns approximately 200 personnel from Rosslyn/Ballston DARP
