**GENERAL DESCRIPTION:** Realign the Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA) Leased Space in Bailey's Crossroads, VA, by relocating Global Information Grid-Bandwidth Expansion (GIG-BE), Global Command and Control System (GCCS), Global Combat Support System (GCSS), Network Centric Enterprise Services (NCES) and Teleport Program Offices to Peterson Air Force Base, CO. Realign NAVSURFWARCEN, Panama City, FL, by relocating Deployable Joint Command and Control (DJC2) Program Office to Peterson Air Force Base, CO. Realign Ft. Monmouth, NJ, by relocating Joint Network Management System (JNMS) Program Office to Peterson Air Force Base, CO. Close the Joint Tactical Radio System (JTRS) Program Office leased space in Crystal City, VA. Relocate all functions to Peterson Air Force Base, CO.

Affects the following Army installations:

1. Army PEOC3T, Ft Monmouth, NJ with movement of approximately 4 personnel.
2. Army PEOC3T, Arlington and Bailey's Crossroads, VA, loses approximately 300 mission support contractors.
