Technical Joint Cross-Service Group
Meeting Minutes of March 31, 2003

Dr. Ron Sega, Director of Defense Research and Engineering chaired this meeting. The list of attendees is attached.

The JCSG meeting focused on a detailed discussion of the final draft (see attachment) of the JCSG's report to the Infrastructure Steering Group (ISG). The members made modifications to the draft report. Among the significant decisions were:

- Creation of a C4ISR working group and a Weapons & Armament working group
- Consolidating the functions of air systems, space systems, sea systems, and ground systems into one working group
- Designating two broad functional areas to examine—innovative systems (energy, power, autonomous, etc.) and enabling technology (non system specific: human systems, biomedical, etc.)
- Each of the five working groups will examine technical capabilities in the areas of research, development & acquisition, and test & evaluation
- One analytic team will support all five working groups
- A capabilities integration team, comprised of deputies to the TJCSG principals and leads of the five working groups will integrate and de-conflict the products of the five working groups

The meeting concluded with the JCSG members agreeing to the final report.
