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
BRAC 2005
Technical Joint Cross-Service Group (TJCSG)
Meeting Minutes of February 11, 2004

Dr. Ron Sega chaired this meeting. Dr. Sega opened the meeting by stating the TJCSG is prepared to brief the ISG. The TJCSG reviewed the draft briefing slides. The TJCSG agreed with the briefing except for some minor formatting changes. The TJCSG also discussed the need to finish the scoring and weighting of all the metrics that were left TBD in the report. The TJCSG next debated whether contractor manyears should be counted as part of the military value calculation. For T&E, it was decided to score the workload focus metric under the Operational Impact attribute as 100% for intramural workload and 0% for extramural workload. For Research, it was decided to score the work focus metric under the Operational Impact attribute as 90% for intramural workload and 10% for extramural workload. For Development and Acquisition, it was decided to score the work focus metric under the Operational Impact attribute as 80% for intramural workload and 20% for extramural workload.
