Technical Joint Cross-Service Group (TJCSG)
Daily Conference Call
Meeting Minutes of 4 March 2005

Mr. Shaffer chaired the meeting. The agenda is enclosed in attachment 1. The list of attendees is enclosed in attachment 2. The primary objective for the meeting was to review the status of the candidate recommendation packages. The agenda topics are listed below in the order in which they were covered. The key points, decisions and action items from the meeting are as follows:

ISG Feedback

Key Points:

- TECH-0005 and 0006 were approved. Navy requested that all of the Corona relocations from TECH-0005 and 0006 be moved to Port Hueneme instead of the cited installations.
- The Air Force and the Navy were interested in having the Flight Testing and Training moved from PAX River to Edwards AFB with some type of Joint management structure at Edwards AFB.
- The Navy is no longer looking at vacating Lakehurst.
- TECH-0047 was approved, but there was an interest in possibly moving the workload to STRATCOM or possibly even JFCOM instead of Peterson AFB.
- The C4ISR Subgroup indicated Offutt reported no C4ISR workload so there is currently no Military Value located at Offutt for C4ISR workload.
- A concern was raised that expressed concern that the TJCSG needs to improve the explanation of the Joint C4ISR strategy.
- The ISG set a hard cut-off for candidate recommendations of 8 March 2005, unless the IEC directs additional scenarios.

Decisions:

- The TJCSG decided to look at an excursion of TECH-0006 which will move everything from Corona to everywhere except Port Hueneme. Also, the TJCSG will look at another excursion of TECH-0006 which will move everything from Corona to Port Hueneme. The TJCSG will then assess the potential need to look further at scenario(s) in between these two.
- The TJCSG will work together with the Education and Training JCSG at the possibility of moving the Flight Testing and Training from PAX River to Edwards AFB with some type of Joint management structure at Edwards AFB.
- The TJCSG will confirm the explanation of the Joint C4ISR strategy to ensure it is consistent.

The TJCSG will then assess the potential need to look further at scenario(s) in between these two.
2. The TJCSG will work together with the Education and Training JCSG at the possibility of moving the Flight Testing and Flight Training moved from PAX River to Edwards AFB with some type of Joint management structure at Edwards AFB.
3. The TJCSG will relook at the explanation of the Joint C4ISR strategy to ensure it is consistent.
