Technical Joint Cross-Service Group (TJCSG)
Daily Conference Call
Meeting Minutes of 9 March 2005

Dr. Segal chaired the meeting. The agenda is enclosed in attachment 1. The list of attendees is enclosed in attachment 2. The primary objective for the meeting was to review the status of the candidate recommendation packages. The agenda topics are listed below in the order in which they were covered. The key points, decisions and action items from the meeting are as follows:

Candidate Recommendation Package Status

Key Points:

- TECH-0018C and the HS&A scenario will most likely be combined into a single CR under the lead of the TJCSG. A number of locations for realignment need to be added to the combined CR.
- TECH-0018E is still a working process.
- TECH-0031 is still having the data validated with the Army. The expectation is that this will be ready by tomorrow.
- The Navy is running a scenario for the closure of Crane. TECH-0042 part 11 moves the technical functions out of Crane (mostly sensors workload). However, this workload was not reported in the scenario data call. The Industrial JCSG has some depot workload at Crane as well and wants to move it to Tobyhanna. The Navy would like to close Crane. However, the Navy wants the IJCSG and TJCSG workload to move to the same location.

Decisions:

- TECH-0040B will be deleted.
- The TJCSG decided to apply the billet reductions identified in TECH-0042A/Part 10 to both Part 2 (currently approved Candidate Recommendation) and the combination of Parts 2 & 10 (the alternate) and proceed to run COBRA on both. The TJCSG will review the results of the two COBRA runs and decide whether or not to replace the currently approved candidate recommendation with the alternate.
- The Navy will provide the TJCSG with the Crane closure data so the Analysis Team can run TECH-0042 part 11 along with the closure action for Crane.

Other Information:

- The next TJCSG Meeting will take place on Thursday, 10 March 2005, from 1200-1400 hrs EST, in the Pentagon, Rm 3E1014.

Action Items:

1. Apply the billet reductions identified in TECH-0042A/Part 10 to both Part 2 (currently approved Candidate Recommendation) and the combination of Parts 2 & 10 (the alternate) and run COBRA on both. The TJCSG will review the results of the two COBRA runs for TECH-0042A and decide whether or not to replace the currently approved candidate recommendation with the alternate.
2. The Navy will provide the TJCSG with the Crane closure data so the Analysis Team can run TECH-0042 part 11 along with the closure action for Crane.
