- DoD's only Western Power Projection mission for wartime munitions out-load
- Design, develop, install, and train operators on Ammo Peculiar and Chemical Demil Equipment: ISO 9001:2000 Certified
- Major convergence of trans-continental rail, interstate highway and airline transportation systems; \$8.4M rail upgrade completed in 2000
- Sole source for base operations support to Deseret Chemical Depot

- Add earth covered magazines to increase storage capability – vast expansion possibilities
- Deseret Chemical Depot planned facilities merger
- Additional ammunition maintenance, demil and outloading capability
