

<h3 style="text-align: center;">Scenario</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Close 3 and realign 8 leased space locations in Arlington, Virginia by consolidating Naval Systems Management Activity (NSMA) leased locations and co-locating with Office of Naval Research, the Army Research Office (DC location only), the Air Force Office of Scientific Research, and DARPA at Naval Support Activity Dahlgren. 	<h3 style="text-align: center;">Drivers/Assumptions</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Principles: Organize; Quality of Life. ■ Transformational Option: Eliminate leased space US-wide.
<h3 style="text-align: center;">Justification/Impact</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Eliminates over 550,000 equiv. GSF of leased space within the DC Area in 11 locations. Computed space required at 200 GSF/person = 326,000 GSF (+ unknown amt. for AFOSR) ■ 3 leased locations can be closed: approx. 120,000 USF ■ Affects more than 1,800 personnel. Scenario estimates a 14% personnel savings for NSMA as a result of consolidation, or 93 positions, and a 7% personnel savings for the other activities as a result of co-location, or 79 positions. ■ Enhances AT/FP. ■ Naval Support Activity Dahlgren reports no vacant administrative space and sufficient land to accommodate 2.3 million GSF of new administrative space. ■ Co-location of organizations with like missions promotes “jointness” and creates opportunities for synergy. ■ Co-location of organizations facilitates possible consolidation of common support functions. 	<h3 style="text-align: center;">Potential Conflicts</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Relocation of large users may conflict with planned usage of space/land on the target installation. ■ DARPA may object to relocating. ■ DARPA’s large contractor community may need to relocate; this target space does not include contractors in contractor-provided space. ■ The Technical JCSG may have competing scenarios.
